Sport England welcomes the site requirement for the enhancement of and provision of additional playing pitches and associated facilities in the existing recreational open space to the north of Pendeford Mill Lane, including improved active travel links from the new neighbourhood. However, the scope of works is not clear i.e. what pitches and ancillary facilities are to be delivered? Further to the above, Sport England would encourage flexibility within the policy to ensure that should the envisaged works not be capable of being delivered that the off site contributions could be secured in alternative locations which would benefit the occupiers of the allocated site.					
Further to the above, the policy is not consistent with Future Playing Pitch Requirement 2022 Topic Paper which states that the strategic site allocations would contain on site playing pitch and changing provision.
