In general terms we support the settlement hierarchy and the recognition that growth should be located at the most accessible and sustainable locations. However, the approach to the distribution of development means that a number of sustainable locations are only planned to receive a minimal housing allocation. For example, of the 7 tier 3 villages, only two are subject to a new housing allocations.							
Additional development should be directed to the villages in order to bolster their services and facilities. A number of the settlements have schools, shops and public houses that would actively benefit from additional households. They are sustainable in their own right and have local housing needs (both market and affordable) that are not being met by the plan.
