It is stressed that the Local Plan emphasises the need to 'ensure there is sufficient supply of employment land to meet the needs of the district over the plan period' (Policy EC1 Sustainable Economic Growth), along with contributing towards the employment needs of the wider functional economic market area (FEMA) arising from the Black Country authorities. Providing sufficient employment land is key to the achieving the Economic Prosperity Strategic Objective and wider Local Plan Vision. We support this principle.

However, we maintain our objection to wording of Policy DS3, which seeks to control development in the open countryside, described in the policy wording as *'land being outside of the Green Belt and defined settlement development boundaries'*.

For the reasons summarised in our response to Chapter 4, to promote flexibility and resilience in delivering economic growth, and to ensure that employment land can come forward to meet market demand at the appropriate time, we consider Policy DS3 should be amended to enable the delivery of additional large-scale employment sites in appropriate open locations, as and when required to address the needs of SSDC and the wider FEMA.

Paragraph 2.1 of the draft Local Plan identifies that 'much of South Staffordshire (80%) lies within the West Midlands Green Belt, with the area beyond the Green Belt too the northwest of the district defined as 'Open Countryside'. The same can be said for a very large proportion of the FEMA. This means that there is a very limited amount of land not within Green Belt that could deliver strategic employment opportunities while also being well connected to the strategic transport network. Policy wording in the plan should enable non-Green Belt sites to come forward



for employment development where there is evidence of a need to meet market demand. This is in line with paragraph 89 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) which states *'planning policies and decisions should recognise that sites to meet local business and community needs in rural areas may have to be found adjacent to or beyond existing settlements*.' [Savills Emphasis]. This amendment would ensure that the draft plan is positively worded and effective.

Furthermore, in terms of meeting the identified employment land needs of SSDC, the deliverability of the ROF Featherstone allocation (E18) should be confirmed, as the site has been allocated for a significant period with no indication of progress on site to date.

It is requested that the following additional text be included in Policy DS3 as a penultimate paragraph in the policy:

Where evidence indicates an immediate need or demand for additional employment land (Class E(g)ii, E(g)iii, B2 and B8 or sui generis employment generating uses) that cannot be met from land allocated in this plan, the Council will favourably consider proposals that meet the identified need in appropriate locations outside of the district's settlements in the open countryside. Such development should be delivered in accordance with the requirements of other policies within the local plan.

It is also requested that the fourth paragraph of Policy DS3 be amended as follows to provide the flexibility needed to address the employment needs of South Staffordshire:

All types of development in the Open Countryside which are not explicitly supported by Policy DS3 will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Such proposals will only be permitted where they are not located on best and most versatile agricultural land where the benefits of the scheme outweigh the economic and other benefits of that agricultural land and are fully consistent with any other relevant policies set out elsewhere in the Local Plan. These include, but are not limited to, policies which relate to the district's:

- overall development strategy
- design standards
- landscape character and assets
- historic assets
- ecological assets and biodiversity
- recreational assets
- housing mix requirements (where applicable)
