Sport England welcomes the site requirement for the enhancement of and provision of additional playing pitches and associated facilities in the existing recreational open space to the north of Pendeford Mill Lane, including improved active travel links from the new neighbourhood.						
However, the scope of works is not clear i.e. what pitches and ancillary facilities are to be delivered and how will this meet the needs identified within the Playing Pitch Strategy? Sport England notes that the Council's recent stage E document highlights that there has been a growth in team numbers and the Football Foundation highlight this would correlate with increased demand for pitches. As such, would there now be a demand for onsite provision?						
Sport England would encourage flexibility within the policy to ensure that should the envisaged works not be capable of being delivered that the off site contributions could be secured in alternative locations which would benefit the occupiers of the allocated site.
